

title. This Act may be cited as the
"Pilot Project to Involuntary Admission on an
Inpatient Basis in the Eastern Iowa Mental Health
Treatment Act."

As used in this Act:

"Department" means the Department of Human Services.

"Eastern Iowa Mental Health Region" means the Iowa counties
of Allamakee, Black Hawk, Clayton, Fayette, Jackson, Muscatine, and Scott.

"Inpatient" means subject to involuntary admission on an inpatient
basis. "Inpatient mental health facility", and "recipient" have the
meanings ascribed to them in the Mental Health and
Developmental Disabilities Code.

"Pilot project area" means the Eastern Iowa Mental Health
Region and Rock Island County, Illinois.


"Receiving agency" means a mental health facility located
in Rock Island, Illinois which accepts and provides treatment
to a person from the sending state.




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


Crisis System of Care




RYC Promotes Access Via Telehealth in Eastern Iowa MHDS Region
