**No one should have to accept violence as part of their job.** Currently, no federal law protects health care workers from workplace assault or intimidation. **Congress should enact the Save Healthcare Workers Act (H.R. 3178/S. 1600), which provides protections similar to those that exist for flight crews, flight attendants and airport workers.**
